Abstract (250- 300 words) should be in the following manners:

- Paper Title (font size 14)
- Author (s)
- Affiliation with email ID and cell
- Purpose
- Design/ Methodology/Approach
- Findings
- Research Limitations/Implications
- Originality/Value
- Keywords (up to 5-6, or at least 2, in alphabetical order)

- Title- Title should not be more than 6-9 words
- Font Size- Heading 14, Text 12
- Format- A4 size, MS Word
- Word Limit (max)- 5000 to 5500 words
- Font- Times New Roman
- Margin- 1.5 inch on all four sides
- Line Spacing- 1.5
- Definitions- Paper should clear and concise with proper definitions for specialized terms.
- Inclusions & Abbreviations. Any abbreviations used should be written in full at first followed by the abbreviations in parenthesis.
- References- The Harvard system should be used in referencing. Example- Adam, J. (2015). Dutch Citing Practices. The Hague: Holland Research Foundation.
- Foot Notes- Should be numbered consecutively in the text and should be typed on same page they are denoted.
- Declaration- Author must declare originality of work. The article should not have been published or be submitted for publication elsewhere.
- Decision and Copyright- Editorial Board's decision will be final. The copyright of all accepted papers will vest with University of Applied Science in Nysa, Poland
