Students' application for an international mobility at University of Applied Sciences in Nysa is only possible by use of the online application form available on website www.erasmus.pwsz.nysa.pl. The following documents must be enclosed and sent by airmail to IRO, together with the printed and signed online application form:

- Learning Agreement containing planned course units in our institution. The Learning Agreement may be modified after arrival and discussion with the academic coordinator.
- the Transcripts of Records obtained in previous years of study at home university
- Confirmation of English Language Competences

3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
4. Termination of the agreement

This agreement can be terminated at any time by mutual consent. In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September of one given year will only take effect as of 1 September of the next year. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
